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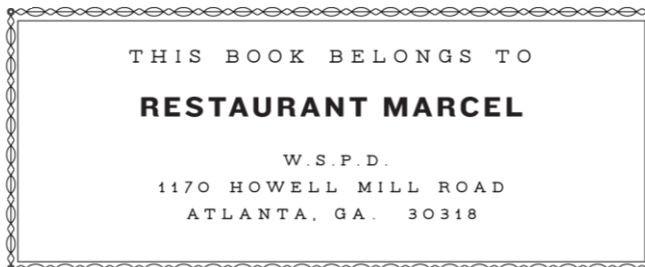

Loire Valley White

Whether it is mineral-rich Muscadet paired with oysters, or brilliant Sauvignon from Sancerre matched with goat cheese, the Loire sets the standard for pairing a classic white wine with an amazing meal. Much of this region is still desperately underrepresented in the US, but we are thrilled to see current trends turning towards these kinds of artisanal, natural, and often breathtaking tastes. This is nervy stuff; a beverage intended to stop a drinker in their tracks with haunting precision. Sometimes, it feels as though vigneron in the Loire have managed to bottle pure electricity.

Burgundy White

It's difficult to argue that any other white wine grape is as influential or as pervasive as Chardonnay. Here, in the appellations of its ancestral home, Chardonnay takes a decidedly elegant form. Whether laser-like Chablis or heady Meursault, these offerings provide a sense of white wine's true purpose; to excite with a purely delicious, integrated style. Wine aficionados often ponder out loud the qualities which elevate these wines to regal status. The beauty of these wine is trenchant, and seemingly strikes deeper than other white wines possibly can.

Northern Rhône
